5. Literacy Night/Heritage Showcase

On Thursday, March 13 th, Mantua will hold its annual Literacy Night/Heritage Showcase for students and their families. Mantua families from over a dozen countries will have displays and samplings at the Heritage Showcase in the cafeteria from 6:30pm – 7:30pm. Classrooms will be open from 7:00pm – 8:00pm. Families can tour the building to learn how students at every grade level acquire literacy across all areas of the curriculum.

6. Lido Place Walkway Public Hearing on March 10, 2008 at 3:30 p.m.

Attention Mantua families: The Board of Supervisors has a walkway project identified as the Lido Place Walkway Project Number W00700 (W719). This project consists of the construction of approximately 650 linear feet of 4-foot-wide concrete walkway, including some re-grading of the existing yards, driveways, drainage ditches and the installation of one 15-inch concrete culvert along Lido Place between Southwick Street (Route 978) and Horner Court (Route 2571).

The construction of this project requires the acquisition of one (1) sidewalk easement and five (5) grading agreement and temporary construction easements in the Providence District. Although the Land Acquisition Division (LAD) has been negotiating to acquire these land rights since April 25, 2007, as of this date, it has been unable to reach resolution due to property owner concerns about the project. Repeated deferrals to move forward on the project have meant increases in project costs. Thus, condemnation is necessary.

Pursuant to section 15.2-1903 (Supp.2006) of the Virginia Code a public hearing is required before property interests can be acquired by eminent domain proceedings. To demonstrate your support for this walkway

project, it's important that you attend the public hearing. Let's provide a safe walkway for our children to get to and from school. For more info on the hearing, please call Fairfax County Government Center at 703-560-6946. http://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/providence/012808lido.htm

"We're Counting on You"

- The 2008 Virginia School Census begins March 1, 2008 and concludes
- July 15, 2008.
- The commonwealth of Virginia requires each school division to conduct a

census every three years.

• Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) needs to count every person residing in

Fairfax County who will reach his or her first birthday but not his or her

twentieth birthday by December 31, 2008.

• For the 2008 Virginia School Census, each child counted will bring

approximately \$3,000 back to Fairfax County Public Schools in tax dollars.

- All households in Fairfax County are mailed a census form.
- There are four ways to respond to the 2008 Virginia School Census:
- 1) Respond online at www.fcps.edu/census.
- 2) Mail in the form.
- 3) Respond via fax to the 2008 Virginia School Census office.
- 4) Respond via interactive voice response system.
- Children attending private schools and those home-schooled are counted in the

2008 Virginia School Census.

- All data collected are kept confidential.
- Data gathered help projections for future school needs.

• Translation assistance is available in Arabic, Chinese, Farsi, Korean, Spanish,

Urdu and Vietnamese.
