11. MONEY FOR MANTUA WHEN YOU RECYCLE YOUR OLD PRINTER CARTRIDGES, CELL

PHONES, PDAS, AND LAPTOPS!

Don't forget to bring in those used ink jet or laser printer cartridges, cell phones, laptops, or PDAs from home or work and place them in the gray rubbermaid container in the front lobby of Mantua school. You can also include any accessories like chargers, extra batteries, cases, headsets, etc. Mantua elementary earns oney for recycling all of the items through the Cartridges For Kids program.

12. Rat Poison Alert

Please warn your children that if they see a neon green/blue brick about the size of a popsicle to not touch it and to notify an adult immediately. It's rat poison!

What we have determined is that someone has initially misused the product by scattering the bricks around instead of having them secured in a rodent trap. When not secured, the squirrels pick up the bait bricks and bury them. As the squirrels unearth the bricks, animals and children are at risk.
