The cost is only \$1.50 for students.

A favorite breakfast item has returned: French Toast Sticks with Syrup.

The breakfast menu is always listed on the monthly lunch menu.

The menu has a variety of hot and cold items to choose from.

The Office of Food Service has told us that our numbers are low. We have to have an average of 35 students daily per quarter in order to keep our breakfast program. September through December we averaged 21 students daily. If it stays low the breakfast program will no longer be available after Spring Break. Instead we will only be able to provide a Breakfast Box consisting of cold items.

7. Ram Sports Camp offered at Robinson Secondary School

This will be our eighth consecutive year for Ram Sports Camp at Robinson Secondary School. Our camp has grown from a total of 150 campers the first year of camp to over 900 in the summer of 2008. Our mission is to offer quality instruction in many different sports for students in the Greater Fairfax area. We have been successful due to the coaching and teaching staffs of Robinson Secondary School, "The Home of Champions," they provide a majority of our instruction.

A variety of activities are offered, including tennis, basketball, cheerleading, gymnastics, indoor soccer, football, field hockey, lacrosse, and track and field.

The activities are broken up into sessions. AM runs from 8:30 - 12:30 and PM runs from 1:00 - 3:30. Campers are welcome to participate in multiple sessions each week. We also offer an Extended Day program from 3:30-5:00 for those families who have childcare concerns. Campers who are

participating all day will have a supervised lunch break from 12:30 - 1:00.
