FCPA Superintendent Modifies Recommendation for Makeup Days

Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) Superintendent Jack D. Dale has modified his recommendation to the Fairfax County School Board on how to make up four instructional days that have been lost due to inclement weather. Based on feedback from parents and employees, the Superintendent is recommending that FCPS follow original 2009-10 calendar, which includes a full day of school on Monday, April 12, ar school on June 23, 24, and 25, to make up the four-day deficit, and allow the use of . 28, 29, and 30 as subsequent makeup days, if needed, due to future school closings t winter. The School Board will make a final decision on the makeup plan at its regular business meeting on March 4.
