Mantua Town Hall on Administrative Boundary Adjustment to be Held

FCPS is considering an administrative boundary adjustment, which could reassign two areas of the Fairhill Elementary attendance area to Mantua Elementary. The areas that are being considered are the Pine Ridge-Sutton Place and Chesterfield Mews neighborhoods, both of which are located south of Route 50. An administrative boundary change is defined by FCPS such that "less than 5% of the enrollment of each school will be affected, and analysis indicates the change will improve the operating efficiency of the school division." The **maximum** number of students would be approximately 30 children spread across seven grades, although the actual number may be considerably fewer. FCPS is holding a town hall meeting to discuss the possible boundary change on Tuesday, March 22, at 7 p.m. at Mantua Elementary. More information can be found <u>HERE</u>.
