# UPCOMING MEETING: Potential Boundary Changes to Mantua-Frost-Woodson Pyramid

Please contact PTA President <u>Lesley Kowalski</u> if you would like to attend or participate in these meetings, as these boundary changes could have a profound

impact on our current pyramid makeup of Mantua-Frost-Woodson. These meetings are open to everyone, but it would be helpful if the PTA can have a sense of who is attending.

The School Board took action at its January 24th meeting to approve the following schools in the Fairfax-Lanier Boundary Study: Chantilly High, Fairfax High, Falls Church High, Oakton High, Robinson Secondary, Woodson High, Franklin Middle, Frost Middle, Jackson Middle, Lanier Middle, and Rocky Run Middle.

The public is invited to participate in community dialogue meetings to discuss scenarios for the movement of students to relieve overcrowding at Fairfax High and Lanier Middle. These meetings will be identical in format and information presented. All meetings will be from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m.

February 20th - Lanier Middle School, Cafeteria, 3801 Jermantown Road (snow date is February 27th)
