Is your child a mathematics lover? If so you may want to learn about the American Mathematics Competitions 8 (AMC-8) examination. As a parent initiative, the test will be administered on Tuesday, **November 13th** at Mantua Elementary School.

The AMC 8 exam is a challenge appropriate for students very interested in mathematics that are enrolled in 6th grade, as well as 5th grade students capable of solving at least half the questions on an previous AMC-8 exam. The exam format is 25 multiple choice questions during a 40 minute period and is administered by the Mathematical Association of America (MAA).
