Fundraisers

- We are expected to receive a check from the Box Tops collection in December for a little over \$1700.00 (\$1,763.40)

- Our Escript income to date is \$436.05

- The Printer Cartridge recycling program has given us \$76.75

• CogAT Scores and AAP pool letters will be arriving home soon - The number of students who have been found eligible for the AAP pool is quite a bit lower than usual because of a new formula. There are a number of children that are probably higher overall than the children in the pool. This is because they are only taking the composite score of the CogAT (132 or above), which is not actually an average. It used to be if you got a 132 of any of the 3 subtests orNaglieri, you would be in the pool. So, there are many children with high 120's or 130/131 that are not in the pool. If you get scores and your child is not in the pool, please feel free to self refer.
