Reminder About Kiss and Ride

For those of you who use Kiss and Ride at the end of the school day, you may have noticed that dismissal is taking longer than usual. This delay is resulting in students who ride buses getting home significantly later than usual. Please remember that buses are scheduled to be at Mantua by 4:00 p.m. Due to the volume of cars, they are stuck in the Kiss and Ride line and not able to get to the bus loop on time.

For afternoon dismissal, we are asking parents to not arrive in the Kiss and Ride line UNTIL AFTER 4:05 p.m.

Currently, Kiss and Ride traffic on Kirkwood is already blocking the entrance to Horner Court by 3:45 p.m., and buses are not able to pull in the bus loop to load bus riders.

Our hope is that by having buses arrive a few minutes earlier and delaying the time Kiss and Ride cars block Kirkwood, we can have dismissal completed faster for everyone while maintaining a safe environment for all. This can only be accomplished with your cooperation.

In addition, please remember that students should not be

dropped off at Mantua before 9:00 a.m. Thank you in advance for your help!

The Mantua Raccoon Runners is a positive youth development program for girls and boys in third through sixth grades. This

program will empower young boys and girls to be true to themselves through lessons in positive body image, health and nutrition and social awareness. This will all be done while we strengthen ourselves through various fitness activities as we train for a 5k run. Any student is eligible to participate.
