# Fairfax County Science & Engineering Fair

This year's Fairfax County Science & Engineering (FCSE) Fair will take place on **Saturday May 13, 2017** at George Mason University. <u>https://www.fcsefair.com</u>

The FCSE fair will accept projects in the areas of Life and Earth Sciences, Physical Science and Engineering. The divisions are: Division I (grades 1-3) Division II (grades 4-5) Division III (grades 6–8)

Students are encouraged to begin working on their projects now so that sufficient time is allowed for planning, data gathering, and final presentation of results. Students are expected to keep a journal documenting the progress of their investigation. Please make sure students know this before they get started.

The FCSE fair has several requirements in advance of project start and submission this year, including a checklist, research plan/project summary, and an approval form. If there are more interested students than available slots allotted to Mantua (which we will find out in early April), we will schedule an in-school science fair, tentatively Wednesday April 19.
