The National PTA has partnered with Chrysler in a program called **Cars For Classrooms**. A local Chrysler dealer brings in a vehicle and donates \$10 for each parent that does a test drive. Might be something to consider.

FCC PTA Update:

The Whole Foods fundraiser raised \$28,500 for FCC PTA. From these funds, \$3,000 being set aside as grant for local PTAs although they haven't yet determined how it will be distributed.

FCC PTA is going to do an Advocacy Day. Bring local representatives together to do break out sessions. Think this will be December 4th.

Terri sits on the AAP Advisory Committee for FCC PTA. This committee is charged with the Young Scholars Program that looks at underrepresented children, kids who are generally pointed out by teachers.

Terri also sits on the Calendar Committee for FCPS. There is a radical calendar proposal on the table but not yet finalized. The committee has representation from all parts of the district – administrators, teachers, parents... Has to get passed by the school board.
