## Welcome Take Home Reading Volunteers

# Each parent usually comes one day/week, for 1-2 hours. A classroom coordinator will create a weekly schedule which meets the needs of the classroom teacher.

- 1. Remove books from the students' Take Home Reading (THR) envelope. Mark them as returned (V) or not returned (NR) on the envelope.
- 2. Choose another book from the correct bin for the first child. On the THR form, each child will have a color next to their name corresponding to the appropriate drawer.
- 3. The drawers are organized by level:

#### Pink (ABC books/prereaders) Red Yellow Green Blue

4. For each student, record the book title next to their name on the THR form. If a student is absent, record 'A'. If a student doesn't return their book record 'NR'.

- 5. Quietly remove the first student from the classroom.
- 6. Read the book with the student. See the notes on the back of this page about tips for reading with different types of readers.
- 7. If the child struggles, there is a laminated sheet in each bin with helpful hints.
- 8. Record the book title on the THR envelope.
- 9. Place the book in the envelope.
- 10. Send the child back to class with their envelope. Ask him/her to send out the next student so you don't have to enter the classroom.
- 11. When you are done for the day, mark where you stopped, so the next parent can continue there.
- 12. Write notes you think the teacher should see with questions or comments.

## Do's and Do Nots for Volunteers

DO:

- Contact the classroom coordinator if you can't come on your assigned day.
- Read with as many children as you can every time you are here.
- Ask each child to send out the next student instead of you interrupting the class.
- Mark where you stop on the list of students so the next parent can begin there.

## DO NOT:

- Bring young children with you when you volunteer.
- Change a child's level, for any reason. Teachers assign levels for specific reasons. No matter what you see while reading, please assign books which represent the level assigned by the teacher.
- Interrupt instruction to speak with the teacher. Leave a note if you have a question or comment.
- Discuss what happens during THR with others. Please remember you must keep the work confidential.
