Homemade or purchased cakes should be dropped off in the school cafeteria Friday, March 19<sup>th</sup>, between 3:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. Remember...the more sprinkles and frosting, the more popular the cake!

### **Enter Mantua's annual carnival theme cake decorating contest!**

Judging begins promptly at 7:30 p.m. Friday, March 19th. Drop off contest cakes in the cafeteria between 3:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.

Please bring your cake on a disposable plate or container, preferably wrapped in clear plastic. Label the type of cake, i.e. yellow cake with chocolate frosting. Helpful hint: You can buy foil pans with plastic lids at Shoppers Food Warehouse or try the dollar store. Bake the cake, let the kids decorate, snap on the lid and you're done!

### **Cake decorating contest rules**

- All cakes must reflect this year's carnival theme, "The Olympics".
- Great prizes from local businesses will be awarded for first, second and third place winners in the three age categories grades K-3, grades 4-6, and grade 7- adult. All other Mantua age participants will receive 6 carnival tickets.
- Cakes entered in the contest by children must be decorated by children, not parents.
- Be original! No decorated cake kits, please.
- All contest cakes will be used for the cakewalk. They cannot be returned.
